

EASTER EGG DECORATIONS

DIRECTIONS:

Removing the yolk

1. With your raw egg in one hand, carefully puncture one end of the egg with a safety pin. Be very careful.

2. Move the pin around so that the hole becomes larger, and hopefully the yolk will break.

- 3. Puncture the other end of the egg in the same way.
- 4. Hold the egg over a bowl and allow the yolk to drain.
- 5. When you no longer feel egg yolk inside, rinse off the outside and let dry.
- 6. Repeat this process for as many eggs as you want to decorate.

Otherwise for a more kid friendly option

- 1. Boil the eggs in a saucepan of water for 5 7 minutes.
- 2. Remove and place in cold water for a further 30 minutes.
- 3. Set aside hard boiled egs to decorate.

EGG DECORATING IDEAS

ldea #1

Cover the egg shell in glue and cover it in colourful glitter. This works best if the glitter is in a bowl so the eggscan be fully submerged. Disco eggs!

Idea #2

Go in to your backyard and pick up pretty findings from nature - leaves, flower petals and grass. Glue these bits to your eggs for a more rustic look to your Easter basket.

ldea #3

Get the paints out and paint your eggs with your favourite colours. Get creative and paint squiggles and lines around your egg.
